

Stratis Kolibianakis is Assistant Professor in Obstetrics-Gynecology and Assisted Reproduction at the Unit for Human Reproduction, Medical School, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece (2005- present).

He got his Medical Degree from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (1991), and his MSc in Medical and Pharmaceutical Research (2002) and PhD on the optimization of GnRH antagonist stimulation (2004) from the Dutch Speaking Brussels Free University in Belgium. He has published several chapter in books, 130 papers in peer-reviewed scientific journals (PUBMED, October 2014), has 3804 citation (SCOPUS, October 2014) and a Hirsch Index of 35 (SCOPUS, October 2014). Professor Kolibianakis has given more than 130 presentations at international meetings. He is also a reviewer for several international journals in the field of Reproductive Medicine and has been on the editorial boards of *Human Reproduction* (2005-2009), *RBMOnline* (2009-present) and *Fertility-Sterility* (2011-present). He is currently the coordinator of the Special Interest Group Reproductive Endocrinology (SIG RE) of the European Society for Human Reproduction and Embryology (ESHRE).
